

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is a sport & social club?

A service of providing dynamic sports leagues and social events to adults age 21 & up. Some might consider playing sports and socializing as two separate events, but we see them as one in the same. Meaning not only can one event contain both sport and social activities, but putting the two together creates the optimal experience for any participant.

2. How old do you have to be to participate?

In order to participate in any league or social event you must be 21 or older at the time of registration.

3. What is an individual sign-up?

Currently we will only be accepting individual sign-ups. Which means after registration closes players will be assigned to a team. Registration will close a week before the start of the league.

4. My friend and I both want to play, but only if we're on the same team, can you make that happen?

Yes we can! When you sign-up there is a box asking if there's anyone you'd like to be teamed with. Simply put each other's names in there so we know to match you up.

5. I am a former D-1/Professional athlete, can I play?

Players that have participated in Division 1 or professional sports must be 2 years removed from participation if they wish to play in a similar Ultimate sports & social club sport.

6. Can I play on multiple teams?

Players may only play for 1 team and can only be listed on 1 roster for any given night, regardless if multiple divisions are offered on that night. Any player that breaks this rule will result in both of their teams to forfeit games played on that day. Players are allowed to play for different teams on different nights.

7. What is your refund policy?

Generally speaking, there are no refunds for any reason, including (but not limited to) illness, injury, relocation, etc. If for any reason we can't run a league you signed up for, you'll be refunded in full.

8. Can my game time be changed?

To be fair to everyone we will not change your game time once the schedule has been posted unless there was a mistake in the schedule or a change in field availability.

9. I can't make it to every game during the season, can I still play?

Yes you can! Just inform your teammates.

10. I forgot my uniform at home, can I still play?

All players must play in team issued shirt. Without one, you must switch out with a teammate when you are on the field of play. You will be roster checked to ensure you are on the team. One day tournaments will be the only exception to this rule.

11. Can I give my shirt to someone else and have them play for me if I will be missing a game?

No, only players on the roster are eligible to participate.

12. What is the post game happy hour?

This is a chance for players and teams to hang out with each other to socialize, drink, and eat at the sponsored bar.

13. Can we bring alcohol to the games?

No alcohol is allowed unless otherwise noted.
